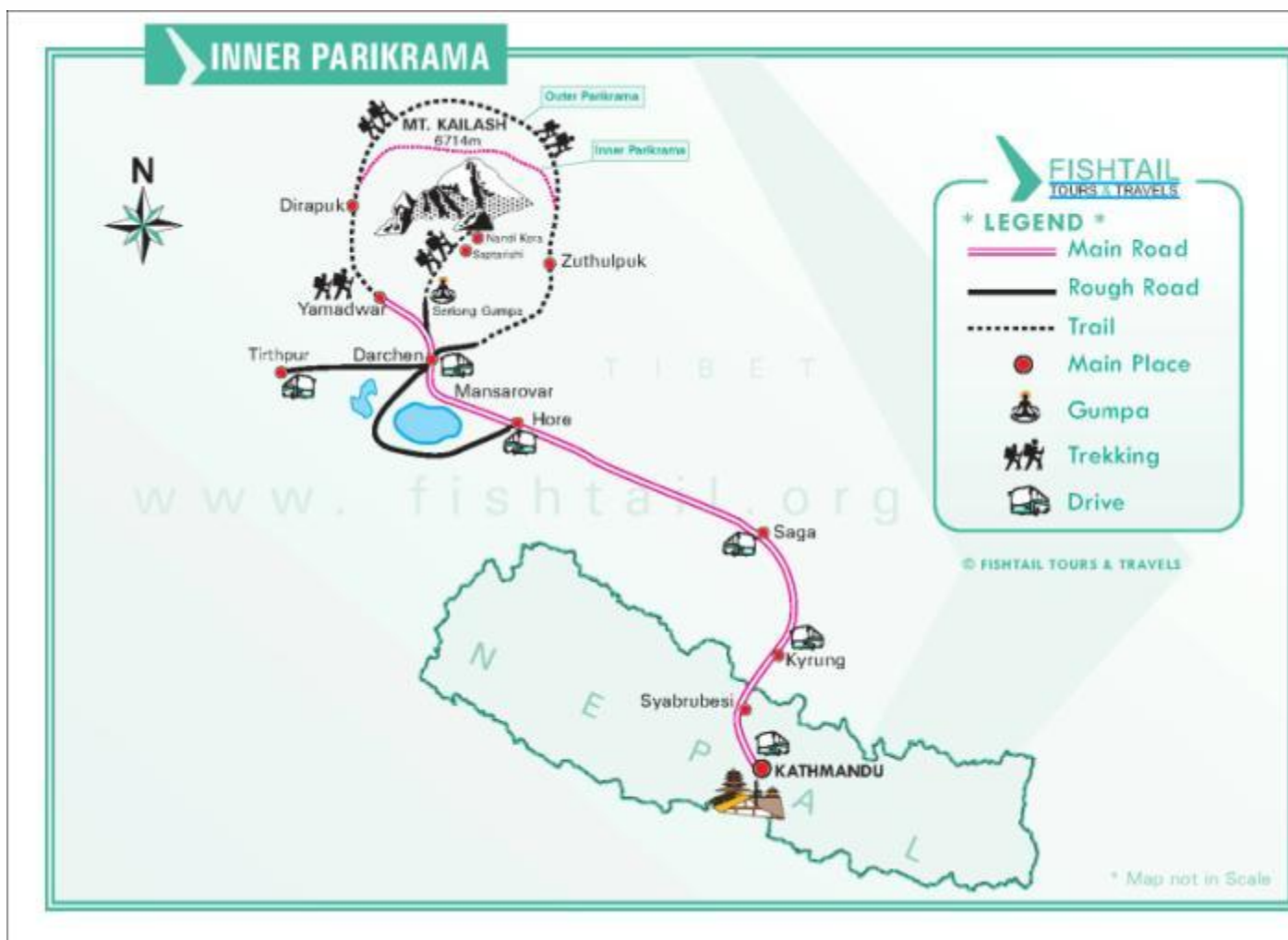

Day 09: Visit Charan Sparsh , Polung Glacier and North face and return to Dirapuk,

Day 12: Drive to Serlong Gumpa and trek to Saptarishi / Nandi Korra and return to Darchen.

DETAILED ITINERARY:-

DAY 01: ARRIVAL AT KATHMANDU (1,350 M), Dinner
Arrival at Tribhuvan International airport (1,350 M), meet and welcome by our office representative & transfer to hotel. Overnight stay at hotel.

DAY 02: TRIP PREPARATION & KATHMANDU SIGHTSEEING, B/L/D

Breakfast leave for Pilgrimage sightseeing tour to Pashupatinath temple, Boudhanath stupa and Budanilkantha temple. Return to hotel, lunch and preparation for yatra. Overnight stay at hotel.

DAY 03: DRIVE TO SYABRUBESI (140 KM, 8 hrs drive) B/L/D
Drive to Syabrubesi (1,550 M). After arrival at Syabrubesi check into the hotel. Overnight stay at hotel

DAY 04: DRIVE TO KYRUNG (20+ 25Kms 1 hours drive) B/L/D
After breakfast drive to Nepal China border, Timure (20 km, 30 Mins drive). Complete Nepal and China side immigration formalities & walk further ahead & get introduced with your Chinese guide / coach drivers. After introduction, proceeds the journey to Kyrung (2,700 M, 20 km, 30 mins drive). Arrive at Kyrung and overnight stay at guesthouse.

DAY 05: DRIVE TO SAGA (105 KM, 4 hours drive) B/L/D
After breakfast drive to Saga. En-route you will witness beautiful waterfall, rivers and mountain along with Tibetan landscape. After approx. 4/5 hour's drive you will reach to Saga (4,640 M). Arrive in Saga and overnight stay at hotel.

DAY 06: DRIVE TO MANSAROVAR, (410 Kms, 7/8 hours drive) B/L/D
After breakfast, drive to Mansarovar (4,556 M). Arrive Mansarovar, take a holy bath; perform Puja, Hawan, and Devtarpan etc (self). Freshly cooked dinner will be served at the edge of Mansarovar Lake. Overnight stay at guesthouse.

DAY 07: DRIVE TO DARCHEN (30 KM, 1 hour drive) B/L/D
Drive to Darchen (4,675 M), en-route visit to Chuigumpa hot spring will be organized. Finally arrive at Darchen and overnight stay at hotel.

DAY 08: HOLY TREK TODIRAPUK (8 Km drive and 10 Km trek) B/L/D
With packed lunch box, drive to Tarboch Flag Pole, the first prostration point, - an auspicious gateway and the sky burial ground. Visit Yamadwar and further drive to Serzhong. Meet your porters/ pony caretaker etc. and trek to Dirapuk (4,765 M). Overnight stay at guesthouse



DAY 09: VISIT POLUNG GLACIER & NORTH FACE

B/L/D

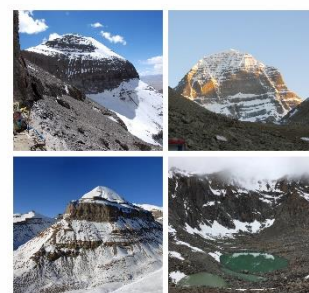
After breakfast start trek to close of North Face, bottom of Mt. Kailash (6,714 M) and Polung Glacier. Return to Dirapuk (4,765 M). Lunch and overnight at guesthouse/ Camp.



DAY 10: HOLY TREK & CLIMBING TO ZUTHULPUK

B/L/D

Early in the morning start climbing via Khandasang La, KuberKund to east face. Light lunch served on the way. Camp at third prostration point/ Zuthulpuk. Dinner & overnight at guesthouse.



DAY 11: HOLY TREK TO DARCHEN

B/L/D

After breakfast start trek to Darchen (4,675 M, 14 Kms, 2 hours trek) .Overnight stay at hotel at Darchen.

DAY 12: VISIT TO NANDI PARBAT, ATMA LINGAM ETC.

Early morning drive or trek to Serlong Gumpa. Proceed trek or climbing further to Atma Lingam, Kuwar Kund, Nandi Parbat etc. Return to Darchen and overnight stay at hotel.



DAY 13: VISIT TIRTHPURI & DRIVE TO SAGA

Breakfast and drive to Tirthpuri (45 km, 1 hours drive). Visit Tirthpuri and drive to Saga (4,640 m, 430 km, 7/8 hrs drive). Packed lunch will be served on the way. Overnight stay at hotel at Saga.

DAY 14: DRIVE TO KYRUNG (105 KMS, 4/5 HRS DRIVE)

Drive to Kyrung (2,700m, 105km, 4/5 hrs drive). Arrive Kyrung city and check into hotel. Rest of the day is free for personal activities. Overnight stay at hotel.

DAY 15: DRIVE TO BORDER & DRIVE TO KATHMANDU (165 KMS, 8/9 HRS DRIVE).

Early morning, after breakfast drive to Nepal China- Friendship Bridge (55 Km and 1 hours' drive). Complete China side Immigration formalities and proceed further to complete Nepal Side immigration formalities. After completion of immigration formalities, you will be driven to Kathmandu (165 Km, 8/9 hours' drive). Dinner and overnight stay at hotel.



DAY 16: PUJA AT PASHUPATINATH TEMPLE

Breakfast and proceed to Pashupatinath Temple for Holy water offering. Return to hotel and free time until your departure transfer to the International airport for your onward flight. Overnight stay at Kathmandu.

DAY 17: DEPARTURE

Our cheerful representative will drop you off to the airport three hours prior to the flight departure. The mystic land of the Himalayas holds many more secrets to be told. Come back again for another adventure visiting our spectacular mountains.

OUTLINE ITINERARY:

Day 01: Arrive Kathmandu and transfer to hotel,

Day 02: Drive from Kathmandu to Pokhara via Manakamana,

Day 03: Fly from Pokhara to Jomsom & drive to Muktidham by local jeep & return to Jomsom,

Day 04: Fly from Jomsom to Pokhara & half day Pokhara sightseeing,

Day 05: Fly from Pokhara to Kathmandu & join on Holy Mount Kailash Yatra program.

DETAIL ITINERARY:

DAY 01: ARRIVE KATHMANDU & TRANSFER TO HOTEL,

Dinner

Arrive in Kathmandu and transfer to your hotel. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

DAY 02: DRIVE TO POKHARA VIA MANAKAMANA

B/L/D

After breakfast drive from Kathmandu to Pokhara (925 meter, 200 KM, / 7-8 hrs drive). En-route visit to Manakamana temple by cable car. Pray to God Manakamana- wish - filing goddesses , lunch and drive to Pokhara. Arrive Pokhara and check into hotel. Evening visit around the Fewa Lake. Overnight stay at hotel.

DAY 03: FLY TO JOMSOM (2,720 M), DRIVE MUKTIDHAM (3760 M) & BACK JOMSOM- B/L/D

Wake up early in the morning and proceed to airport with packed breakfast for flight to Jomsom. After 25 minutes flight you will reach to Jomsom. Walk to the hotel and separate your clothing and requirements for Muktinath. Walk for 15 minutes to catch local Jeep for Muktinath (30 km , 1 hour drive). Arrive at Muktinath jeep station and start climbing up to Muktinath temple. Arrive at Muktinath temple after approx 15 minutes hiking. Take bath at 108 holy water spouts, perform Puja at Muktinath temple, Jwala Mai etc. and visit around the places of interest etc. Return to Jeep stand for local jeep drive to Jomsom. Arrive Jomsom jeep station, walk to the hotel and overnight.

DAY 04: FLY BACK POKHARA (850 M) & POKHARA SIGHTSEEING

B/L/D

Wake up early in the morning and walk to airport for flight to Pokhara. It is 25 minutes flight. Arrive

Pokhara and check into hotel. Get refreshed and proceed for local half day sightseeing covering Devis Fall, Fewa Lake & Bindabasini Temple. Rest of the day is free for personal activities. Overnight stay at hotel.

DAY 05: FLY TO KATHMANDU & JOIN ON HOLY MOUNT KAILASH YATRA. **B/L/D**

Breakfast and transfer to domestic airport for a flight to Kathmandu (25 Minutes) to join on Holy Mount Kailash Yatra program.

HOLY MT KAILASH AND MANSAROVAR LAKE- AN INTRODUCTION:

Holy Mt Kailash and Mansarovar Lake, center of creation & the Universe are as old as the creation. Thousands of Sages, Ordinary Mortals, Philosophers and even Gods had submerged in the blissful trance at the very sight of this divine grandeur. It is the MERU, SUMERU, SUSHUMNA, HEMADRI (Golden Mountain), RATNASANU (Jewel Peak), KARNIKACHALA (Lotus Mountain), AMARADRI, DEVA PARVATHA (Summit of Gods), GANAPARVATHA, AJATADRI (Silver Mountain). Regarded as SWAYAMBHU, the self-created one, everything is said to emanate from here and finally returns here. Mind is the knot tying consciousness and matter-that is set free here.

Famously known to be an abode of LORD SHIVA and his divine consort PARVATI, Mt. Kailash expounds the philosophy of PURUSHA and PRAKRITI-SHIVA and SHAKTI. The radiant SILVERLY summit is the throne of TRUTH, WISDOM and BLISS-SACHIDANANDAM. The primordial sound AUM (NADABINDU) from the tinkling anklets of LALITA PRAKRITI created the visible patterns of the universe and the vibrations (DVANI) from the feet of Lord Shiva (NATARAJA) weaved the essence of ATMAN, the ultimate truth. The scriptures reiterate that one, who takes the holy dip at Mansarovar and carries out the Parikrama around Kailash, is absolved of his/her sins through generations and is absorbed into the Supreme Finality. There is no re-birth; sorrows or joys and he/she will be with ultimate – the Lord Shiva. In other words, they become Shiva.

In addition to the Hindus, the entire region is also one of the most important pilgrimage centers for the Buddhists. They worship DEMCHOK (Buddha in forceful form) seated on the summit of Kailash. It is also called Dharmapala; one version quotes the deity as a form of Shiva's manifestation. The description of the deity is more or less like Shiva. Devi is also given a similar form like Parvati. Buddhists adore Kailash as KANG RINGPOCHE and Mansarovar as TSO MAPHAM. Guru Rinpoche (The great Indian Master PADMASAMBHAVA who introduced Buddhism) and Saint Milerapaare greatly revered here by the pilgrims. Since TANTRISM runs through the main core of Buddhism here, their customs and practices would be found running close and parallel to Hindu traditions. Like Hindus, they also consider (DOLMA (DEVI) and GAURI KUND (ThukiZingbu) as holiest spots. Buddhists strongly believe that pilgrimage to this place liberates them to NIRVANA.

Besides, Jains acknowledge Kailash as ASTAPADA and PADMAHRADA. It is believed that ADINATH VRISHABDEVA - the first Tirtankara attained Nirvana here. A few claim that GURU NANAK meditated here. Across the river CHU, there on the Nyanri range stands an impressive temple. Inside this monastery there is a marble statue radiating peace and compassion. This statue is claimed to be that of Guru Nanak.

The entire area echoes with spiritual vibrations. Even the agnostics shall discover new balance amidst that fathomless serenity. One has to experience it. The common belief is that those who are ordained only could be there.

INFORMATION

Health Pre-caution: Oxygen is less at higher altitudes. The inclement weather and high altitude induces certain illnesses generally not encountered over the plains. Headache, nausea, lassitude, lethargy, breathlessness, general uneasiness (malaise), high irritability, light loss of balance, disorientation, incoherence and insomnia are to name among a few. It is common to all irrespective of age, sex and physical fitness. Gradual acclimatization is the best answer. Tranquilizers, sleeping dosages and strong antibiotics must be avoided. Some symptoms do indicate that the body mechanism is readjusting to new environment.

Route & climatic conditions: Once the voyage commences, the panoramic Himalaya and Tibet cocoon the pilgrims in their effulgence and they drift beyond the reach of a conventional world. Deep silence and eerie expansiveness rule the atmosphere. A resourceful pilgrim, however, would enjoy his every step – planning is the key. Route from Kathmandu to Tatopani/Rasuwagadi (Timure) (Nepal-China border) is narrow and scary but from the border onward roads are well maintained. The high altitude Tibetan terrain is dry, cold and windy. Night is colder than day. Torrential rains, strong icy winds are common features. The average altitude is above 3,500 meters and the route covers many high altitude passes.

Risk and Liabilities: We will endeavor to make your journey smooth and pleasant as far as possible. However, the entire program in Tibet is conducted strictly under the rules and regulations of China Tibet Tourism Bureau (TTB). Therefore, Fishtail Tours/Trek (P) Ltd. & its related organizations will not be responsible for any changes in the itineraries due to unavoidable circumstances such as government restrictions, delay in receiving Tibet Travel Permit and Visa due to TTB's own rules and regulations, landslides, road blockages, floods, snow, political unrests, cancellation of flights, delay due to shortage of land cruiser Jeep/Coach in Tibet, personal sickness or accident. Any extra cost incurred shall be borne by travelers themselves.

Required Documents:

- Minimum of six months valid passport and two copies of passport size photographs.
- A normal health certificate from your personal doctor for travelers aged 60 years and above may be required (May not be compulsory always)

Fitness: This is not a trek or expedition but a tour; therefore no specific level of fitness is required. Anybody can join this Yatra if they think they are fit and have a strong willpower. People suffering from cardiac or respiratory problems should consult to their doctor. Morning and evening walks, jogging, stretching, meditation and regular exercises make the journey comfortable for all.

Food and Beverages: Delicious continental & Indian food will be served. Breakfasts and Dinners will be served in campsite by trained Nepali staffs. Packed lunch will be provided during daytime. We will serve mineral water for drinking purpose.

Clothing and Necessities: As the temperature varies greatly between day and night (from max. 20 degrees Celsius to min. -16 degrees Celsius) one should prepare accordingly. However, we suggest all yatries to travel light – maximum 10 to 15 Kg per person. We too provide certain clothing and essential from our end. Kindly go through the details and decide the requirement accordingly:

Clothing requirement may vary as per the yatra duration. On the basis of 14 days Overland Yatra, the following clothing are suggested;

Insurance: Full travel insurance covering medicine, Helicopter evacuation (if in case of emergency), loss of personal belongings, postponed/ pre-pond expenses of inward and outward flight and trip cancellation is strongly recommended.

CANCELLATION:

All notice of cancellation must be sent to our office in writing; verbal cancellation will not be accepted. There is no refund for services not used. In case of any cancellation the booking amount will be completely forfeited. In addition, the following cancellation rules will be applicable on the balance amount payable.

- 21 days period from tour departure date: 30% cancellation charges.
- 15 days period from tour departure date: 50% cancellation charges.
- 7 days and less periods: 75% cancellation charges.

The above cancellation rules are applied as per the rules and regulation of China Tibet Tourism Bureau and (IPSC) Indian pilgrims service Center, China

MOST IMPORTANT POINTS TO BE NOTED AND PREPARED:

It should come into notice of all **Kailash Yatrics** that, all Tibet and Holy **Mt. Kailash Yatra**/Tour operators in Nepal have very fewer roles to play in handling Tibet and Holy Mount Kailash Yatra operation. The decision of **Tibet Tourism Bureau (TTB)** and **China India Pilgrim Service Centre (CIPSC)** is final and mandatory to be followed and accepted by all. Hence, interested clients for **Tibet and Holy Mt Kailash Yatra** (especially Indian Yatrics) are requested to be prepared, both mentally and physically, for the following adverse situations and do the necessary preparations accordingly. In case of occurrence of any of the following conditions, the management of **Fishtail Group of Tourism Hospitality** or its associates won't be liable and be made responsible.

Though you might have submitted both your name list with advance payment and the application for the Tibet Travel Permit in time as per the rules, it cannot be guaranteed that the Tibet Travel Permit and the Visa will arrive in time. Sometimes, the Tibet Travel Permit or the Visa might be rejected by the concerned authorities, i.e., TTB and CIPSC at the very last hour (even after your arrival in Nepal or after issuance of your nonrefundable to and fro ticket to Nepal)

In case of failure to obtain the Tibet Travel Permit and the Visa on time as per the stipulated date of arrival/departure, all additional expenses in Nepal (accommodation, food, transportation etc.) have to be borne by the client himself/herself.

In case of rejection of your Tibet Travel Permit and the Visa by the concerned authorities, i.e., TTB and CIPSC, at the last hour (after arrival in Nepal), the client himself/herself has to issue fresh return ticket or manage his/her return journey on his/her own expense.

The entire price given below in Indian currency is calculated at the rate of 83/- per US Dollar, i.e. (ROE) 83/- at the time of pricing. All the difference due to currency fluctuation will be borne by either side.
